The MTC Racing Stewards concluded an inquiry into a report received from Quantilab that Methadone had been detected in a urine sample taken from jockey G. Joorawon on Saturday 17 June 2017.

Jockey Joorawon pleaded guilty to a charge under MTC Rule 53 A (1) (a) in that he presented himself to ride in a race on Saturday 17 June 2017 under the influence of a prohibited substance, namely Methadone.

Jockey Joorawon was suspended from riding in races for a period of six weeks and fined Rs.50,000. This suspension will expire at midnight on 24 August 2017.

Jockey Joorawon will be permitted to ride track work conditional on him providing a urine sample free of any prohibited substances.
