## Mauritius

May 2023 turned out to be the fifth wettest May on record (since 1950) and the second wettest May since the last 10 years, amounting to 291 mm which represents 197 \% of the long-term mean. Rainfall was in excess almost over the whole island, especially at Mon Bois, Mon Loisir S.E and Plaisance, where it was by $240-257 \mathrm{~mm}$.
