Mr. Speaker, Sir,

I am informed that the State Trading Corporation started renting the Liquefied Petroleum Gas storage facilities of Petroleum (Mauritius) Ltd. since May 2020. The rental fees paid for the period May 2020 to October 2021 was USD 27.50 per metric ton.

I am tabling the yearly breakdown of the rental fees paid to Petredec (Mauritius) Ltd. from May 2020 to June 2023.

Mr. Speaker, Sir,

I am further informed that the rental fee was increased to USD 28.66 per metric ton as from November 2021, and that this increase was due to inflation.
