## Mean Rainfall for 1-31 July 2023

## Mauritius

Normal rainfall was recorded in July 2023, amounting to 121 mm which represents $92 \%$ of the long-term mean. Rainfall was deficient in the region of Bel Etang, Sans Souci and Arnaud by $50-75 \mathrm{~mm}$. However locally at Mon Bois, Union Park and Tamarin Estate, it was in excess by $10-20 \mathrm{~mm}$.
