## Mauritius

Above normal rainfall was recorded in August 2023, amounting to 140 mm which represents $130 \%$ of the long-term mean. Rainfall was in excess in the region of Arnaud, Union Park and Bois Cheri by $70-95 \mathrm{~mm}$. However locally at Fuel and Pierrefonds, it was in deficient by $20-25 \mathrm{~mm}$.
