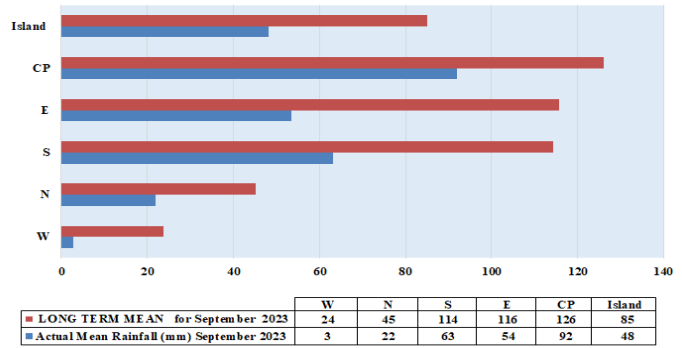

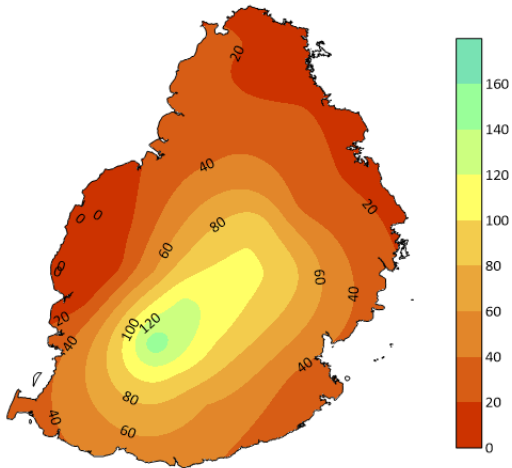
## Mean Rainfall for 1-30 September 2023

### Mauritius

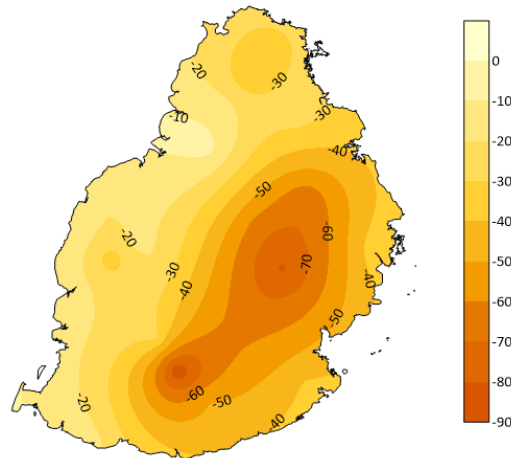
September 2023 turned out to be the 6<sup>th</sup> driest September since the last 30 years. The recorded rainfall was well below normal, amounting to 48 mm which represents 56 % of the long-term mean. Rainfall was in deficient in almost all region especially at Bois Cheri, Sans Souci, Bel Etang and Fuel, where the deficiency was around 65-90 mm
