


Mean Rainfall for 1-15 October 2023

Mauritius


Well below normal rainfall was recorded for the first fortnight of October 2023, amounting to 15 mm, representing 52 % of the long-term mean. Rainfall was deficient in almost all regions, especially at Sans Souci, Bois Cheri, Britania and Bel Etang, where it was by 30-42 mm. However, locally at Tamarin, Mon Loisir, and Pierrefonds, it was in excess by around 5 mm
