## Mauritius

The first fortnight of November 2023turned out to be very wet with 208 mm of rainfall representing $584 \%$ of the long-term mean. Rainfall was in excess in almost all regions, especially at Bel Ombre, Plaisance and Britania where it was by $340-460 \mathrm{~mm}$.
