

Forms of Croquet



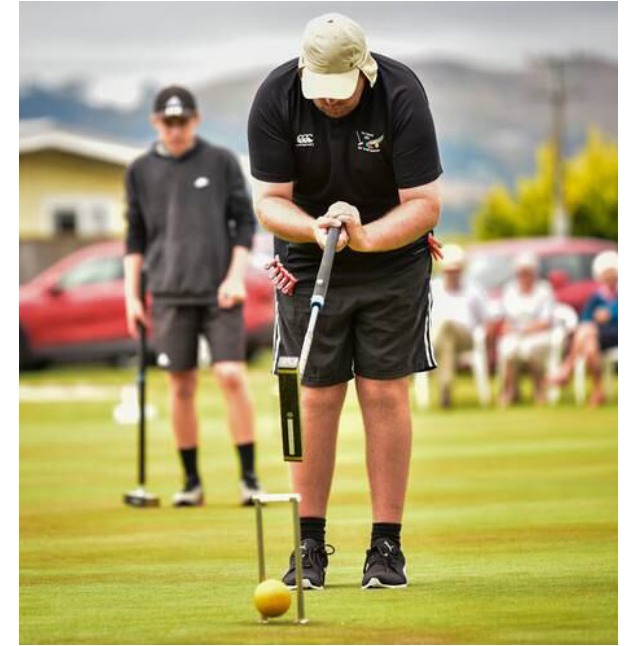
Garden Croquet

Commonly known rules where all players try and get their balls through all 6 hoops, hitting the peg at the end, first to do so wins. Players receive extra turns for going through hoops and hitting other balls.



Association Croquet

One player on the lawn at a time attempting to run their two balls through all 12 hoops and finish with the centre peg. They do so by playing Roquets (hitting your ball into another) and playing Croquets (placing your ball next to the ball that was just hit and hitting your ball again). This allows players to keep their turn going.



Golf Croquet

Players take alternating shots, there are no additional turns. The first player to run a hoop wins the hoop and all players now move onto the next hoop in sequence. Players play best of 13 hoops, so first player to win 7 hoops wins.

Rules of Golf Croquet

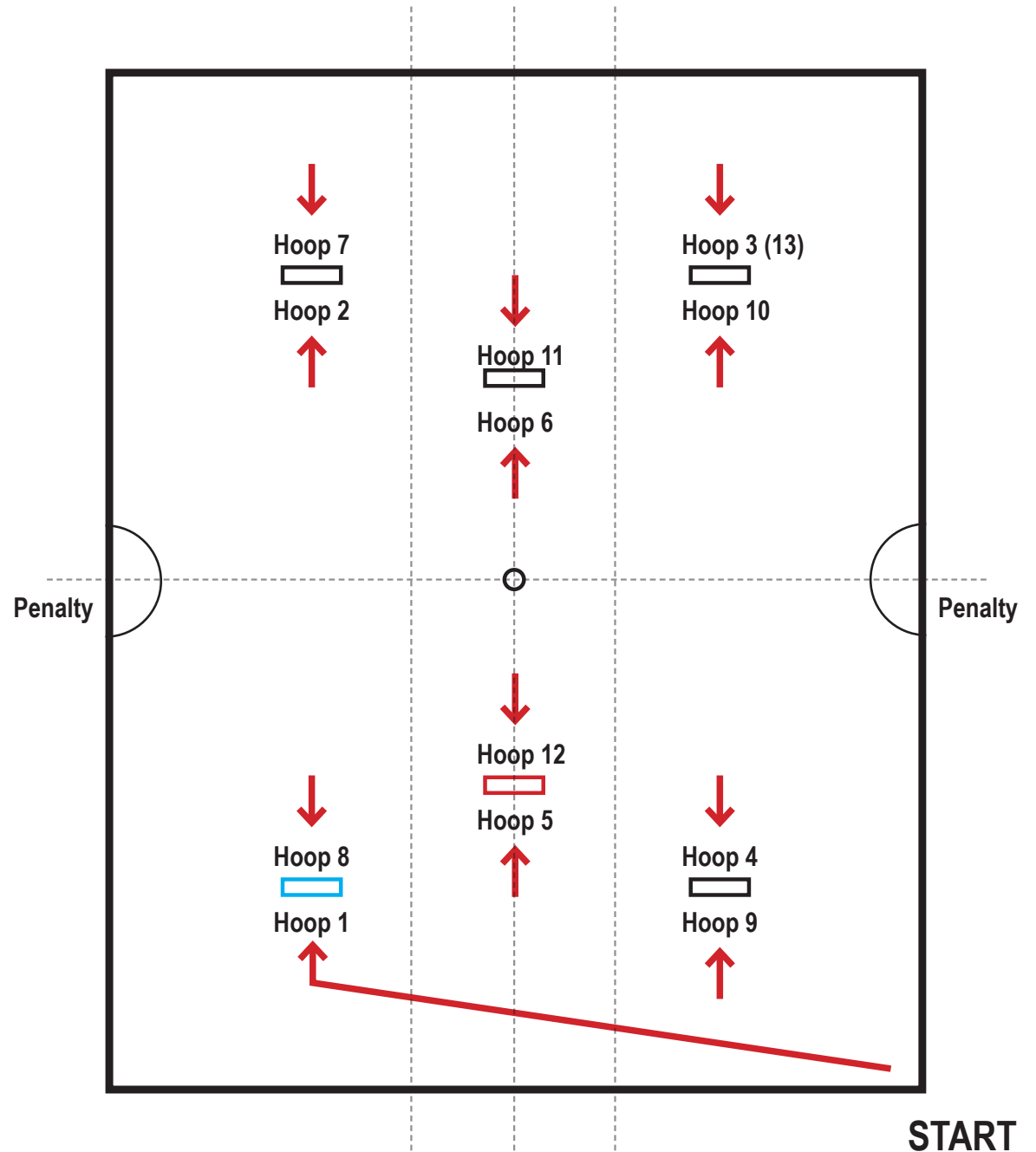
- Play a singles match (two balls each) or a doubles match in teams of 2 (one ball each).

- Players / teams take alternating turns. The blue ball starts, followed by red, black, then yellow. Blue & Black play as a team, Red & Yellow play as a team. There are no additional turns.

- The first player or team to go through a hoop wins the hoop and receives 1 point! All players now proceed to the next hoop. No one else needs to go through the hoop that has been won.

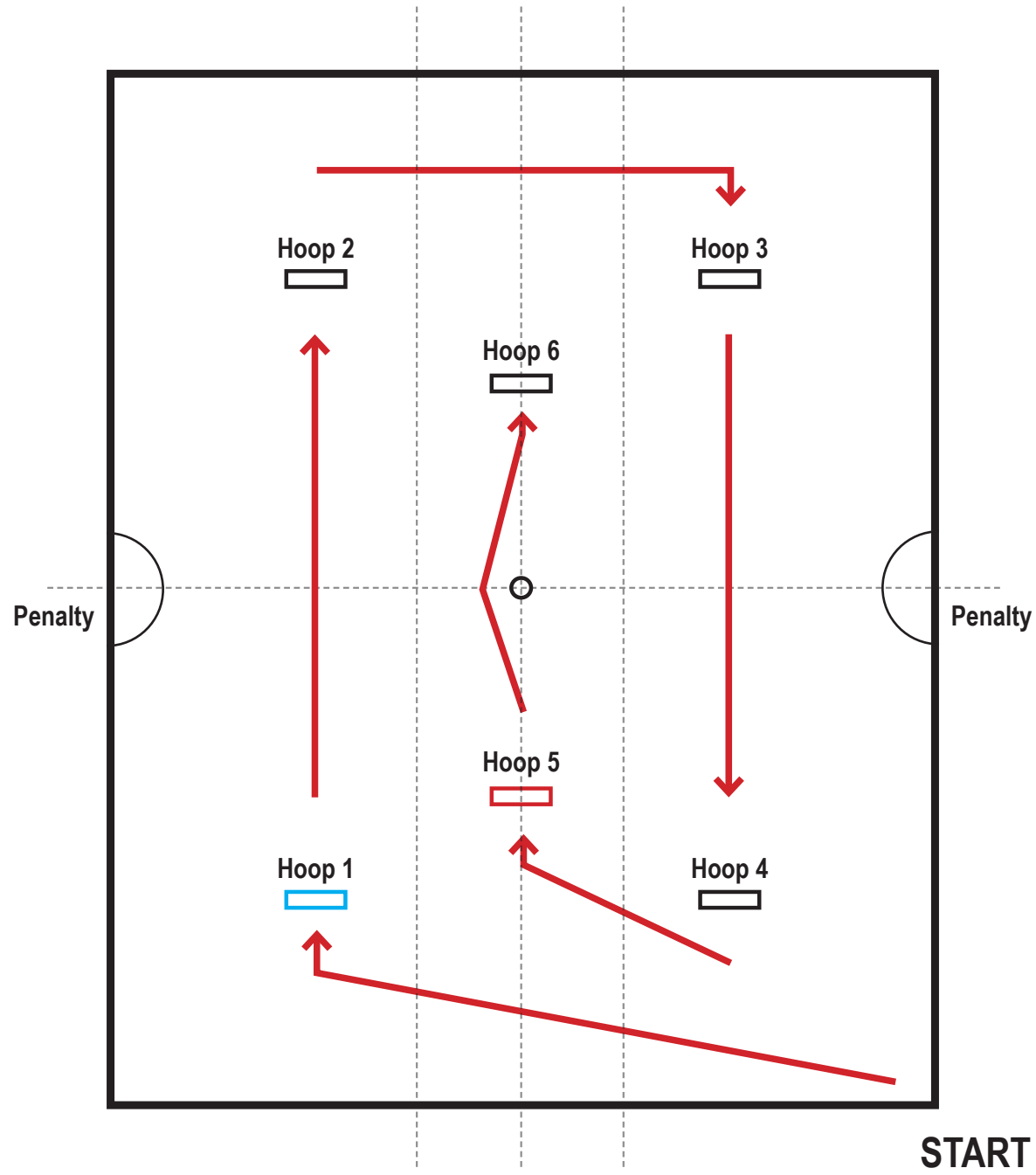
- Players go through all 6 hoops in a sequence that plays the course twice, once clockwise and once anticlockwise. Each hoop won is worth 1 point. Hoops must be entered in the specified direction. Details on following pages. The first player to reach 7 points wins. If after 12 hoops the score is 6 all, player proceed to hoop 13 for a tie-break.

- If a player has hit their ball to a position more than half way to the next hoop, at the moment when the current hoop is won, this ball would be offside. The opponent can choose which penalty spot (P) to place the offside ball, where the player then takes their turn from. They do not lose a turn, play continues in the normal sequence.



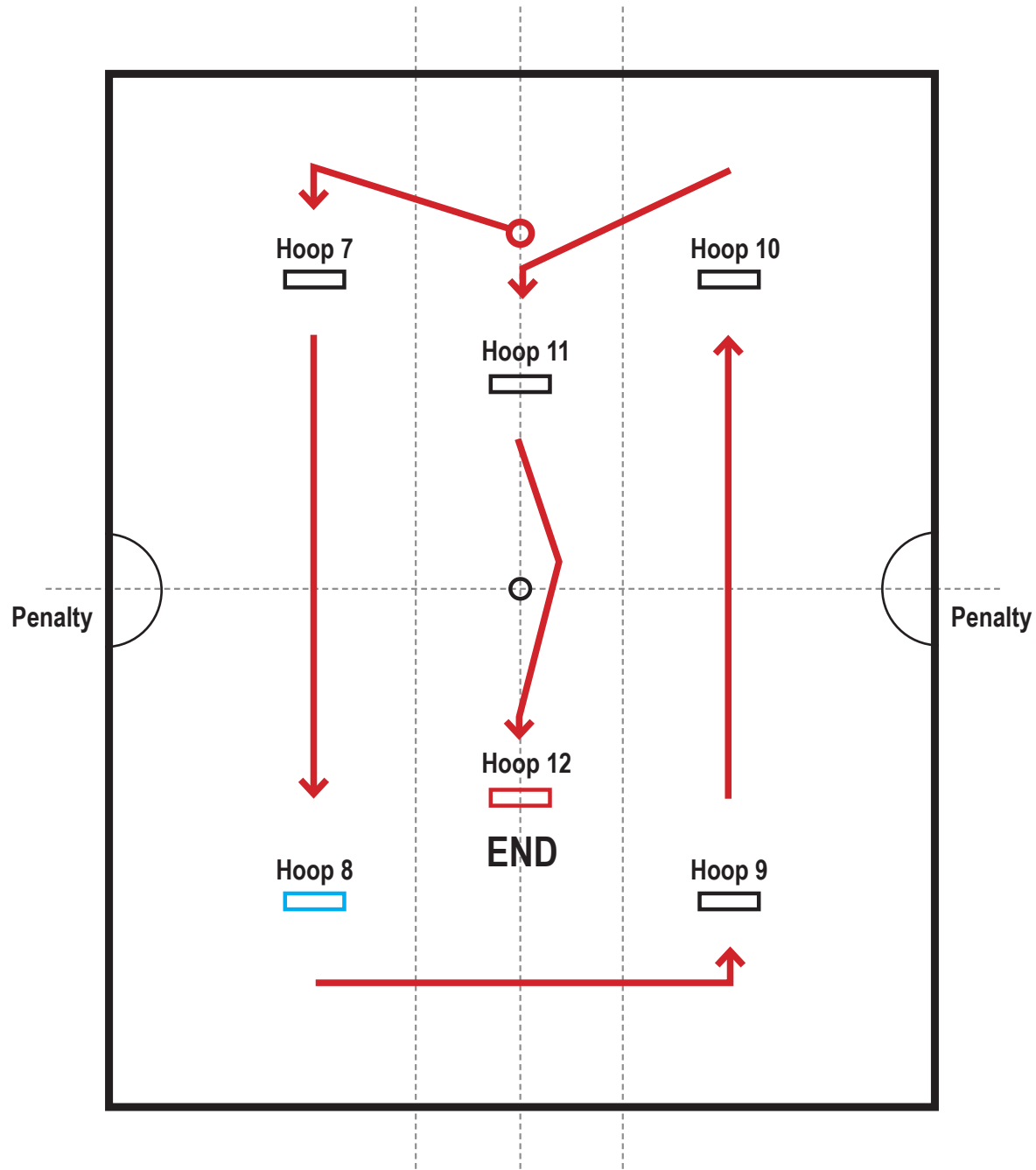
GC Play

Hoops 1-6



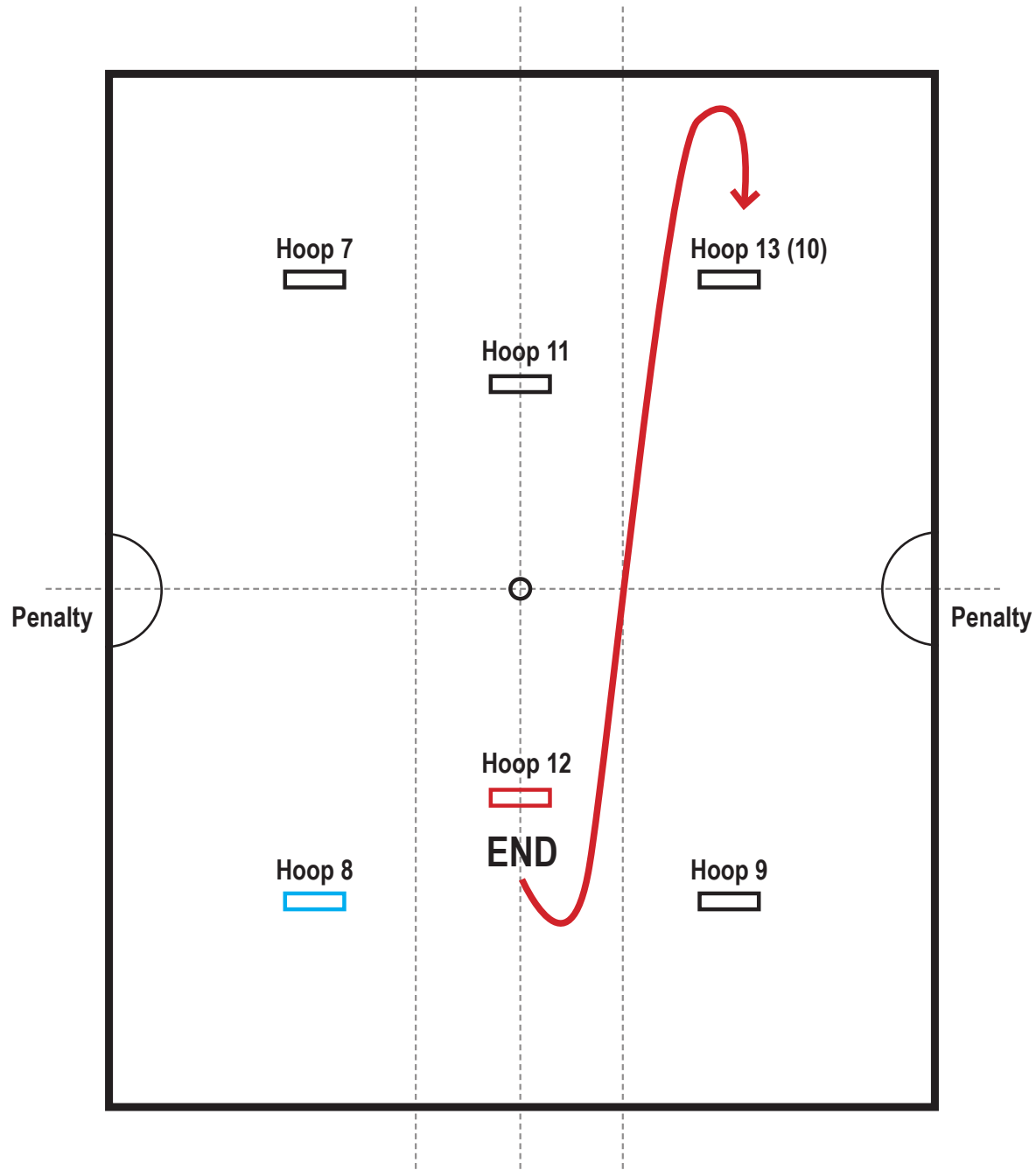
GC Play

Hoops 13 Tie-break



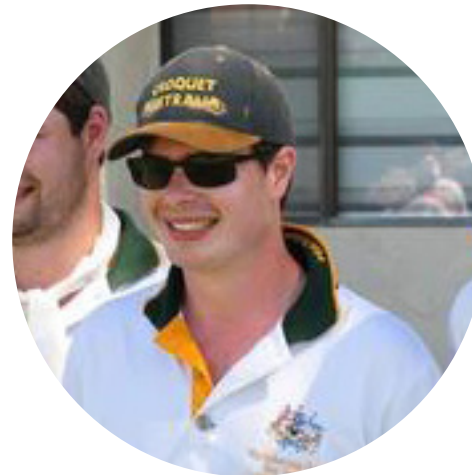
