## Mauritius

November 2023 turned out to be the fourth wettest November on record since 1904 and wettest November since the last 30 years. The record rainfall amounted to 285 mm which represents $336 \%$ of the long-term mean. Rainfall was in excess almost over the whole island, especially at Britania Union Park, Mon Bois and Bois Cheri, where it was by $3650-465 \mathrm{~mm}$.
