


# Mean Rainfall for 1-15 January 2024

#### Mauritius


The first fortnight of January 2024 turned out to be very wet with 403 mm of rainfall representing 317 % of the long-term mean. Rainfall was in excess in almost all regions, especially at Grand Providence, Bel-Etang and Fuel where it was by 415-460 mm.
