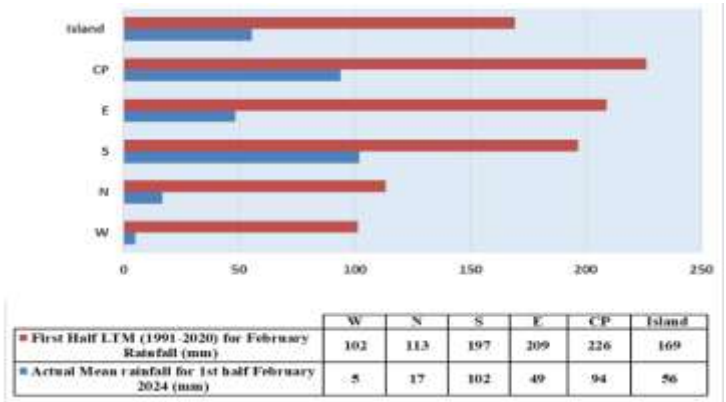

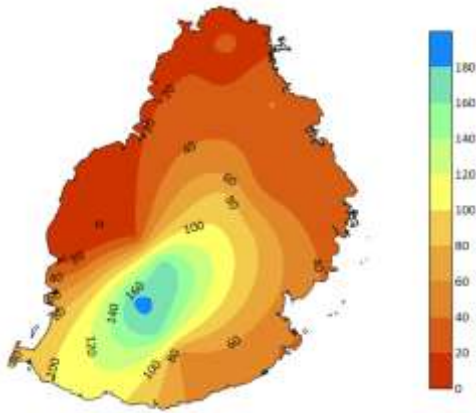
Mean Rainfall for 1-15 February 2024

Mauritius

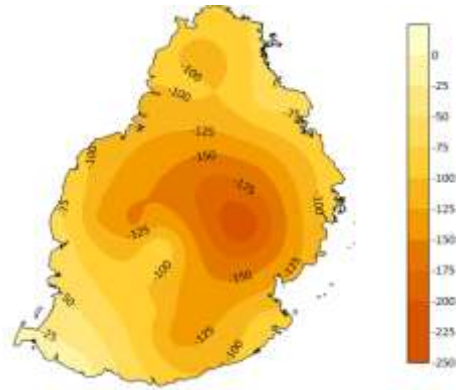
Dry conditions prevailed over Mauritius for the first fortnight of February 2024 with 56 mm of rainfall representing 33 % of the long-term mean. Rainfall was deficient almost over the whole island especially at Sans Souci, Grande Providence, Bel Etang and Vacoas where it was by 145-230 mm.
